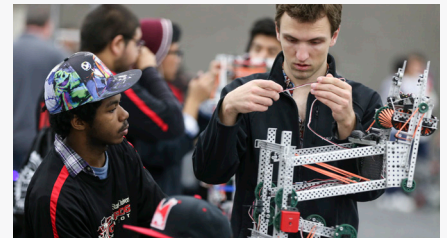
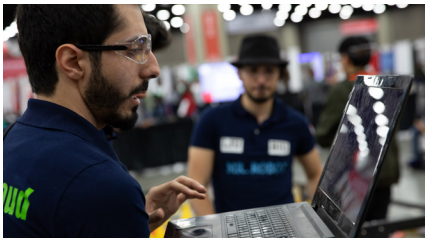

Write a short description of your scholarship offering, approximately 150 words, to be posted on our website. Descriptions best sent as a Microsoft Word document.

3 Organization's Logo

Provide your organization's logo, as an .AI, .EPS, .PDF or .PNG file. If your organization is a university, please provide the university logo and not the one for the individual college or department.

PROGRAM NOTE

Unless otherwise discussed, your organization will receive the students' applications, review them, select and notify winners, and administer funds. Once you have notified your winners, the REC Foundation staff will ask you to share information about your experience and provide the winning student's name, VEX team name and number, and the student's intended course of study.
