



## The 2017 REC Foundation & Texas Instruments Scholarship

The REC Foundation and Texas Instruments are pleased to partner in offering two (2) \$5,000 non-renewable scholarships to two (2) high school seniors intent on pursuing a degree related to science, technology, engineering or mathematics in college.

Eligible students must have participated in one or more of the following programs this season: VEX Robotics Competition, Project Lead the Way (PTLW), FIRST Robotics Competition, or BEST Robotics.

Students **must** submit an essay, up to but no more than 500-words, discussing their participation in the program(s) listed above, their interest in robotics or engineering, and how TI products benefitted their project/design.

To be considered, entries must include:

- Student's name
- School name
- Specify grade level at time of application
- High school transcript with GPA
- Team number in the program(s) of participation
- Document/statement from team mentor verifying student's participation/role in the challenge
- Household income, indicate appropriate category:
  - < \$50,000
  - \$50,000 - \$100,000
  - \$100,000 - \$150,000
  - \$150,000 - \$200,000
  - > \$200,000
- Provide number of dependents (18 years of age or younger) currently in household
- Student's email, mailing address with city, and state and should be submitted to online.
