



Robomatter - REC Foundation scholarship

REC Foundation and Robomatter are pleased to partner to offer one (1) \$5,000 non-renewable scholarship to one (1) high school junior or senior intent on pursuing a degree related to science, technology, engineering and mathematics in college. The award will be presented at the VEX Robotics Competition World Championship in April 2017, but the student does not need to be present to win.

Eligibility requirements:

1. Students must have participated in the VEX Robotics Competition.
2. Students must submit a 500-word essay explaining how their participation in both the VEX Robotics Competition and the Robomatter Sponsored Robot Virtual World Competition enabled them to develop a high competency and appreciation for programming. In addition, students **must** indicate how the use of ROBOTC and Robot Virtual Worlds enhanced their programming skills and their understanding of robotics while aiding participation in the VEX Robotics Competition.
3. Students must have participated in the Robomatter Sponsored Starstruck Robot Virtual Worlds Competition Sponsors by submitting a legal entry to the competition. Verification of submission requires providing the submitting team number and date of submission.
