



The 2017 REC Foundation & Chevron Scholarship

The REC Foundation and Chevron are pleased to partner to offer one \$5,000 non-renewable scholarship to a high school junior or senior intent on pursuing a degree related to science, technology, engineering and mathematics in college. The award will be presented at the VEX Robotics Competition World Championship in April 2017, but the student does not need to be present to win.

Eligible students must have participated in the VEX Robotics Competition and submit a 500-word essay explaining how their participation in both the VEX Robotics Competition has enabled them to develop a high competency and appreciation towards STEM programs including robotics and engineering.

Applications must include:

- Student's name
- School name
- Specify grade level (i.e. Junior or Senior at time of application)
- VRC team number
- Document/statement from team mentor verifying student's participation/role on the team
- Student's email, mailing address with city, and state.
- Use the online application available on the REC Foundation web site to apply.
