Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for a scholarship, students must plan to attend Vaughn College on a full-time basis and pursue a bachelor of science degree in engineering or technology. Potential recipients must be high school seniors who have participated in a *VEX* program while in high school.

Application

To be considered, students must:

- Complete an application for admission to Vaughn College; online application is available at Vaughn's website, www.vaughn.edu.
- Complete the *VEX* scholarship application
- Submit a letter of recommendation from a *VEX* adult mentor or coach.

Note: There are no citizenship or residency requirements and no student essay is required for these scholarships. However, any scholarship is conditioned on the recipient being accepted into a bachelor of science program in engineering or technology at Vaughn.
