### Notes:

- At least one official VIQC event must take place in a state/region/country to receive a spot.
- Spot allocations for each State/Regional/Provincial will be given to that number of different teams.
- If all spots could not be given away, or if a team qualifies multiple times, there will be spots that need to be re-allocated. Remaining elementary school spots will be given to elementary school teams, and remaining middle school spots will be given to middle school teams. The highest, unqualified team on the Robot Skills Challenge Score from the World Robot Skills Standings, from that region will get the spot and be determined after the last State/Regional/Province Championship in that region. Scores from the State/Regional/Province Championship will be included on the World Robot Skills Standings for consideration in this process.
- VEX Worlds qualifications are held for teams for a limited time from the date of the event at which they qualified. Teams that qualify before **February 1, 2019**, will have three weeks to register. Teams that qualify on or after **February 1, 2019**, will have one week to register.
- Payments by Credit Card, Check or Purchase Order must be received by **March 27, 2019**.
