JUDGE (MAY 24 - 25)

Anyone can be a Judge, and no engineering experience is necessary. You will simply be assigned to judge a non-technical aspect of the competition if you are not familiar with robotics. This role is interactive and inspirational, as Judges get to talk with teams and view their work. Ideally, we need judges for multiple days in a row; however, we also have shifts for one and two days:

SHIFTS

May 25, 8:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.

INSPECTOR (MAY 24)

This role is enjoyed by detail-oriented people. Inspectors follow a checklist to make sure that the competition robots are compliant with all the rules (adults only, and training is quick and easy).

SHIFT

May 24, 12:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.

FIELD RESET (APRIL 25 - APRIL 30)

If you want to bring your kids, you can all volunteer together, provided that spots are still available. Even younger kids enjoy Field Reset. They set up the scoring objects on the field after the team finishes their match, using a simple diagram as reference.

SCOREKEEPER REFEREE IN SKILLS DIVISIONS (MAY 24 - 25)

This role is simple. You use a computer to start and stop a timer. That's it! Easy to learn.

SHIFTS

May 24, 12:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.
May 25, 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.
Queuing (May 25)

This is an easy role that gets you near the action where the student teams are competing. The Queue Crew uses a team list to make sure all teams are guided to the correct competition field. This is a great family role, as parents can Queue while kids do Field Reset in the same area. 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.
