



# Inspection

## Live Remote VEX Worlds

### Pre-Inspection

On Saturday, May 15<sup>th</sup> for VEX Robotics Competition teams and May 22<sup>nd</sup> for VEX IQ Challenge teams, there will be open inspection times available for teams unable to make their scheduled inspection time. Teams that know that their scheduled Sunday inspection time will be problematic should be proactive and take advantage of our 3-hour pre-inspection window. Pre-inspections will open for teams that cannot make their Sunday Inspection time from 9:00am until 12:00pm (all times Central). We will be unable to continue inspection beyond 12:00pm, so teams should arrive early and be prepared. Please note that this applies to both LRS and LRT teams and they should login to their respective inspection locations at [console.liveremoteskills.org](https://console.liveremoteskills.org) or [remote.robotevents.com](https://remote.robotevents.com) to complete their inspection during this period.

### Scheduled Inspection

All teams will be required to undergo and pass inspection before they can compete in either Live Remote Tournament matches or Live Remote Skills matches at the VEX Worlds. Teams must pass inspection of both their robot as well as their field and technology setup in order to compete. For teams competing in Live Remote Skills (LRS) inspection will take place at [Console.liveremoteskills.org](https://console.liveremoteskills.org). For teams competing in Live Remote Tournament (LRT), inspection will take place at [Remote.robotevents.com](https://remote.robotevents.com).

Teams will each get a 20-minute time block to complete their inspections. These time blocks will be scheduled by the REC Foundation. Teams will be notified of their scheduled time 7-10 days prior to the day of their scheduled inspection. This notification will be done via email to the primary and secondary contact person for each team. All Inspection Times will be sent in Central Time so please be mindful of time zone differences. Please be on the lookout on your email so you don't miss out on your inspection details.

Teams who miss their inspection time may not be able to get another time slot. Please be ready for your inspection with a complete field and camera setup for either LRS or LRT, as well as your robot at your scheduled time. **Unless special accommodations are made in writing in advance of the event, teams that haven't passed inspection by the deadline will be removed from the team list and match schedule and will not be eligible for a refund of their registration fee. The deadline for VEX Robotics Competition teams is 9:00pm on Sunday, May 16, 2021. The deadline for VEX IQ Challenge teams is 9:00pm on Sunday, May 23, 2021.**

### Preparation

**Field & Technology:** Teams should review the field and technology checklists to ensure their field meets the criteria. If a field doesn't pass inspection, then the team won't be able to compete. This is to ensure that all teams have a great experience during their LRT and LRS matches. Teams are encouraged to test their computer and webcams so that fields are properly in view and all game objects and scoring goals are easily visible to referees, spectators, and other teams.
