

Terms and Conditions

REC Foundation Grant Requirements

Interest surveys are used by the REC Foundation to help determine the needs of our community. We may contact you when there are available grants. Grants are sponsor-specific, limited, and may not be available for your area.

Cost associated with competitive STEM programs include but are not limited to:

- Starter kit
- Field and tiles or Field Elements
- Full Field game elements- (purchased annually)
- REC Foundation Annual team registrations.

Upon approval you will receive and must accept terms and conditions associated with the sponsor's requirements. The following general Robotics Education & Competition (REC) Foundation terms and conditions include:

- Grant recipient/organization agrees to complete the required team roster information to document the eligibility requirements for each team/grant award received.
- Grant recipient/organization agrees to pay for any team registrations, supplies/equipment, and/or shipping costs that may be required by the grant award.
- Grant recipient/organization understands that a granted team registration cannot be applied to a team that is already registered for the current season. Any team receiving a granted registration (initial OR additional) must be unpaid and in the grant applicant's cart upon grant approval.
- Grant recipient/organization agree that grant teams will register, pay for, and compete in one or
 more official REC Foundation competition events for the next two (2) seasons, meaning the
 current season plus next season. Failure to meet this requirement, without a written approved
 extension, during this period or if the grant recipient/organization decides to no longer participate
 in REC Foundation programs will result in all grant supplies/equipment being returned to the REC
 Foundation at the grant recipient/organizations own expense.
- Grant recipient/organization will work with the REC Foundation grant process Team Engagement Manager to utilize the Virtual Skills platform. Virtual Skills is included as a part of a paid team registration.
- Grant recipient/organization agree to complete any research or academic studies within reason
 including pre and post teacher training survey, pre and post student survey, pre and post season
 survey, and individual team profile and team roster profiles and surveys, which include team
 demographic requirements.
- Grant recipient/organization understands discounts are not able to be applied to previous purchases (supplies/equipment), orders that have already been placed or processed, orders that are in a PO received (processing) status or team registrations that have already been paid or are in PO received (processing) status. Grant awards may only be used by the RobotEvents account holder that applied for the grant and cannot be transferred to other RobotEvents account holders or third parties. All grant awards are only valid during the period of validity (current season) and are subject to the term and conditions being accepted by the grant recipient/organization. Any grant award not utilized during the period of validity (current season) will be voided/canceled at the end of the validity period (end of current season). Grant awards may not under any circumstances be converted into a sum of money which is reimbursable or payable to the grant recipient/organization.
- All grant equipment will be stored in a safe, clean location.
- The grant equipment will be used for official REC Foundation competitions or activities.
